The Tuberculosis Association of India (TAI) provides financial assistance to short term research projects on topics/fields which are in line with those proposed to be taken at our Annual National Conference (NATCON). This year's NATCON to be held at PGI, Chandigarh from 16th to 18th December, 2016 may take up the following topics:

The financial assistance up to Rs.50,000/- to each is provided to the selected entries. The researcher (applicant) is expected to complete the project within three months of the approval* thereof by TAI. The amount sanctioned is released in two instalments, the first on approval* and the second on successful submission of progress being made (from after a month of release of first instalment).

*The successful applicants will be required to provide Ethical Clearance of their institutions for the project.

All medical students and doctors are eligible for submitting short term research projects. The proposed project must be forwarded/recommended by the Dean, HOD, Principal of the medical college/institution where the researcher proposes to conduct research. The project can also be forwarded through the State TB Associations.

The research proposals, duly approved/recommended/forwarded by the Head of the Department/Dean of the Institution, Principal of Medical College, State TB Association, Chief Guide, etc. (scanned), including the advance copy thereof, must essentially be sent by e-mail only.

The results/findings of the research may be used by the TAI for publication in its Indian Journal of Tuberculosis. So it may not be given/disclosed by the researcher to any one without the prior permission of TAI.

Last date for submission of research proposals is 30th June, 2016. The final decision on grant of funds will be made by a committee set up for the purpose.
